Rainy weather had been in the forecast, but instead of proving a burden it turned into a blessing at race time. Low flying clouds settled beautifully onto the hilltops near the starting line and the temperature fell into the low 60s. So conditions for distance running were pretty close to ideal when the gun sounded at 0800.

The number of entrants this year was 186 and the number of family teams was eleven, the former of which was somewhat below average for our event. But the race went smoothly and there were no glitches with timing or the results, which were expeditiously reported. The post-race ceremonies were concluded more quickly than last year (by about a half-hour), which is to say, by 10:30. My thanks to the back-room crew for their most efficient job ever!

Trevor Dominy lowered his time from last year by more than a half-minute to win the men's trophy. He was the only entrant in the field to run sub-16 this year. On the women's side, **Natalie Patterson** was our champion. Congratulations to you both! We hope you'll return next year to defend.

There was a surprise ending to the *Fastest Family* competition, given that last year's winners, the **Dominy family**, were there to defend, plus the two-time champions, the **Edwards family**, were at full strength. Meanwhile the perennially strong **Fortner family** were in the mix, too. And then there was the **O'Sullivan family** from West Virginia, who were comprised of great young runners with ages advantageous for our cross-country style scoring system. So who won? Fastest Family Results

Eleven families competed in this year's race, four of whom had either won or medaled in previous years. But two of them were unfortunately also competing against injuries this year and this went against their efforts.

In the end, it was the unranked **Ingram family** that took the day, particularly given the cross-country style, age-group scoring system. (We intentionally adopted this scoring system from the start, first, because the race has its roots in cross country, and second, because it favors multi-generational families, thereby epitomizing running as a lifetime sporting activity.) In this case, we must deeply respect Grandfather Harold's longevity in the sport and the spirited energy of his grandchildren who are new to it.

Notice that had the race instead been scored by cumulative time (which is the tie-breaking procedure) the outcome would have been very different!
